This year, we were extremely honored and fortunate to receive grants from two California funding sources (as authorized by AB1733): CATTA (Child Abuse Training & Technical Assistance Center) and CAPIT (Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention and Treatment). We thank the California Institute on Human Services at Sonoma State University and the L. A. County Board of Supervisors for their assistance in awarding and distributing the CATTA and CAPIT funds (respectively). With the help of the two grants, we created our website, <a href="www.EndAbuseLB.org">www.EndAbuseLB.org</a>. The website lists all of our meeting dates and confirmed speakers for the coming months as well as directions to our meeting location. It also contains detailed information about our current month's program.

For next year's membership application and to nominate a colleague for one of our awards, you can now complete forms online. Website resource information for domestic violence victims includes: hotline listings for area shelters and other victims' services; a link to a California website which assists people in preparing a restraining order packet from the privacy of their own home or safe location; directions for filing a domestic violence restraining order in Long Beach Court and instructions about getting someone personally served. Coming next is resource information for child abuse prevention.

The two grants also enabled us to purchase a laptop computer for use by our speakers and for our general needs, and a digital camera. You can view photos of our special events on the website. Email updates round out our "tech" news: We now send monthly email updates as well continuing to send updates by U.S. mail.
